

REGISTERED NURSE

Employees in this position provide and maintain an appropriate level of health care for incarcerated individuals through the use of approved medical procedures.

Qualifications

- Must be 20 years of age and a United States citizen.
- Must possess, or be able to obtain by time of hire, a valid State of Ohio driver's license without a disqualifying record of suspension or revocation in any state. The Greene County driver's eligibility policy states, no Driving Under the Influence (DUI) or three (3) moving violations within the past three (3) years.
- High school diploma, G.E.D. or equivalent
- Successful completion of an accredited Registered Nurse Program.
- State of Ohio Registered Nurse License.
- Successful completion of background exams as set forth by the Sheriff.
- The candidate must possess good time management skills.
- The candidate must be able to work varied hours and shifts.
- Benefits:

 - Life Insurance Policy provided by the County
 - Ten (10) days vacation after one year of employment
 - Ten (10) paid holidays per year
 - One (1) personal day per year
