**JUDGMENT ENTRY CONVERTING
MINOR GUARDIANSHIP TO MINOR TRUST**
[Local Rule 66.2(G)]

Upon hearing the Application to Convert Minor Guardianship to Minor Trust, the Court finds that notice was served on all necessary parties and no objections to the conversion of the minor guardianship of the estate to a minor trust were presented. The proposed trust agreement has been reviewed by the Court, fully executed, and is approved.

The _____ Trust is established pursuant to R.C. §2111.182. _____, Trustee, has accepted their fiduciary responsibility and is appointed effective as of the date of this Judgment Entry.

The Court assigns Case No. _____ as the new case number for the minor trust proceeding. The Court will file a copy of this Judgment Entry, along the executed trust agreement, under the new minor trust case number.

The Guardian is ordered to comply with all requests of the Trustee to transfer possession of the assets and promptly provide all information and documents relating to the minor guardianship that are necessary to effectuate the transfer of guardianship assets into the newly formed trust. The Guardian is further ordered to file a Final Guardian's Account within 30 days of this Judgment Entry.

It is further ordered that:

- The Trustee must post bond in an amount equal to two times the value of the ward's personal property and annual income. The bond amount is subject to adjustment as the value of the minor's assets and income increase or decrease.
- Trustee's Bond is dispensed with by law.
- By separate Judgment Entry, the Court has dispensed with bond under Local Rule 75.2(G).

Letters of Authority of Trustee of Minor Trust shall be issued promptly upon the filing of the Trustee's Bond or completion of other instructions set forth in this Judgment Entry.
