Who do we serve?

We serve individuals who are currently on or exiting from Greene County Adult Probation.

What do we do?

As staff, we work together to help clients to overcome barriers to living as productive members of society. We also network with local community resources to help our clients become more employable. We strive to support our clients as they work towards their goals, including obtaining and maintaining employment.

What does our program provide?

The GCAPD Job Readiness Program is designed to provide clients with employability skills, job search assistance, and job retention/ follow up. The Job Readiness Program provides:

- One-on-one Sessions
- Resume building assistance
- Job search assistance
- Interviewing skills
- Dress for success
- What employers expect
- 1, 3, and 6 month follow up

We also incorporate an “open door” policy to those who may need assistance beyond the 6 month period.

How can you help?

We need employers who are willing to offer job opportunities to those who are making positive changes in their lives after a felony conviction. By providing employment opportunities to these qualified candidates, you are giving them a change to contribute to society, while they develop a sense of self-worth and responsibility. Ways to participate include:

- Alert us when you have job openings

- Opportunity to participate in community job fairs
