Upon application for appointment of an emergency guardian, the Court finds that \_\_\_\_\_

and further there exists emergency circumstances and that it is reasonably certain that immediate action is required to prevent significant injury to the person and/or estate of the proposed ward, that the proposed ward is incapable of taking care of  self only,  property only,  self and property, and that an emergency guardianship is necessary.

The Court further finds that notice of the hearing cannot be given because of the emergency existing; the incompetent is a resident of this county or has legal settlement herein; and that this Court has jurisdiction.

The Court therefore appoints \_\_\_\_\_ a suitable and competent person, emergency guardian of the  person only,  estate only,  person and estate of \_\_\_\_\_ limited to the following: those powers that are necessary to prevent injury to the  person,  estate,  person and estate of the incompetent.

The Court orders notice of the appointment of the emergency guardian be issued to the ward.
